On October 25, 2007 – during the inaugural year of IHMC -- Canada's Federal Parliament officially declared October as an annual celebration of Islamic History Month in Canada. (IHMC)

IHMC was conceived to motivate and inspire Canadian Muslims to recognize and share Islamic history, heritage and culture with their fellow Canadians during the month of October. This objective can be (and is being) achieved through community and public events such as exhibitions, lectures, celebrity tours, book fairs, and other complementary activities.

During its first three years (October 2007, 2008 and 2009) Islamic History Month offered wonderful riches to all of us through artists blending Islamic traditions with Western approaches to the visual arts, theatre, cuisine, fashion, architecture, literature and music. Thousands of Canadians came to appreciate for the first time how significantly our present-day fields of medicine, architecture, art, law, and mathematics all bear the marks of early contributions from the Islamic world.
